The district Rotary Foundation committee is a group of experienced and dedicated Rotarians who assist the governor in educating, motivating, and inspiring Rotarians to participate in Foundation program and fundraising activities in the district. The committee serves as the liaison between the Foundation and club Rotarians. The district governor is an ex officio member of the committee.

## DISTRICT ROTARY FOUNDATION COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES

The duties and responsibilities of the district Rotary Foundation committee (DRFC) members are to

- Participate in a district Rotary Foundation seminar for club presidents, presidents-elect, club Foundation committees, and other Rotarians in the district when requested
- Participate in the decision process for allocating District Designated Funds (DDF) and encourage full use of DDF
- Upon request, assist the DRFC chair when conducting Foundation sessions at the PETS and district assembly

## DRFC MEMBERS AND SUBCOMMITTEES

Subcommittee chairs are appointed by the governor for the year and automatically become members of the DRFC. These appointments should be based on the chairs' commitment to The Rotary Foundation (TRF) as demonstrated through program participation and financial contributions. The governor also appoints members for open positions on the DRFC subcommittees. Subcommittees are appointed to address ongoing administrative functions, as follows:

- Scholarships
- Rotary World Peace Fellowships
- Group Study Exchange
- Grants
- PolioPlus
- Alumni
- Annual Giving
- Permanent Fund
